

**Resolution authorizing a License Agreement with the City of Columbus for installation of video equipment at the East Opportunity Center in support of the City's Neighborhood Safety Camera Project.
(Public Facilities Management)**

WHEREAS, Section 307.10 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes procedures for the sale, lease, transfer or granting of rights in real property by boards of county commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus ("City"), as part of its Neighborhood Safety Camera Project, is engaged in the placement of video cameras and ancillary equipment in designated neighborhoods as a crime prevention measure; and

WHEREAS, the City requests that the Board of Franklin County Commissioners, the owner of real estate and a building located at 1055 Mt. Vernon Avenue, enter into a License Agreement to allow for the installation of a video camera and ancillary equipment on the roof of the facility in support of the City's Neighborhood Safety Camera Project; and

WHEREAS, the term of the License Agreement shall be for five (5) years, and can be renewed for up to two consecutive terms of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Public Facilities Management recommends the approval of the attached License Agreement, per the terms and conditions of the License Agreement which are fully incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, and is binding on both parties.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the License Agreement between the Board of Franklin County Commissioners and the City of Columbus is hereby approved.
