

Final hearing for establishing, altering and widening of Stelzer Road, County Road No. 177, and Johnstown Road, County Road No. 377, Mifflin Township, Franklin County, Ohio (Engineer)

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to establish, alter and widen Stelzer Road, County Road No. 177, and Johnstown Road, County Road No. 377, Mifflin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, and report to said Board in the manner and form prescribed in Section 5553.06 et seq. of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, this 20th day of September, 2011 was fixed as the date for the right of way hearing in said matter and the County Engineer, having filed his report thereon and plats thereof, recommends that Stelzer Road and Johnstown Road be improved to variable widths as described in said report and shown on said plats; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the improvement were made; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio finds that public convenience and welfare requires the establishing, altering and widening of Stelzer Road and Johnstown Road, as shown in the reports and on the plats submitted by the County Engineer;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That said Stelzer Road and Johnstown Road project is found to be of sufficient importance to public convenience and welfare to cause the above establishing, altering and widening as shown on the submitted plat and recommended by the County Engineer.

Section 2) That the Franklin County Engineer, at his request, is hereby authorized and directed to investigate and recommend the employment of competent appraisers to aid him in determining the value of the land to be acquired.
