

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to enter into a collaboration agreement with the Franklin County Sheriff to implement a one-time inmate reception fee recovery initiative.

WHEREAS, starting January 1, 2012, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Franklin County Sheriff wish to allocate and recover costs of confinement in the most efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.38(A) authorizes the Board to enter into an agreement with the Sheriff to require any inmate confined in a Franklin county Corrections Center as a result of pleading guilty to or having been convicted of an offense to pay a one-time reception fee for the costs of processing the inmate into a Corrections Center at the time of the inmate's entry into the Corrections Center; and

WHEREAS, an inmate reception fee of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) will be assessed in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 2929.38(B); and

WHEREAS, A similar initiative has been implemented in Hamilton County, Ohio; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That, in accordance with the preamble, which is incorporated herein, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio hereby enters into an Agreement with the Franklin County Sheriff in order to implement the attached one-time inmate reception fee initiative.
