

Resolution to accept participation of eligible communities in the County's Township Nuisance Abatement Demolition Program
(Economic Development & Planning)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, Franklin County has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant for certain community development activities; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 98-11 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's 2011 Annual Action Plan and which was approved by the Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledging this community development need, fulfilling all requisite citizen participation requirements related to that plan and approving this allocation within; and

WHEREAS, the County received funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") under the Community Development Block Grant program as regulated by 24 CFR Part 570 and will implement a nuisance abatement program; and,

WHEREAS, the executed Cooperation Agreements allow the County to undertake or assist in the undertaking of nuisance abatement demolition pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 505.86; and,

WHEREAS, all required resolutions reaffirming participation and authorizing the Demolition Participation Agreements with the Board of Franklin County Commissioners are attached hereto, and made apart hereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio:

The County accepts the participation of eligible communities in the Township Nuisance Abatement Demolition Program, and agrees to engage the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission to oversee the abatement of each project attached hereto, upon such terms and conditions acceptable to the County.
