

The Clotts Road culvert replacement and road improvement in Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio declared necessary (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Jefferson Township has expressed a need to replace an aging culvert and headwall and to replace failed pavement on a portion of Clotts Road, between the township line near Riva Ridge Boulevard and the entrance to Gahanna Middle School East, Jefferson Township, Franklin County Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson Township has requested that the Franklin County Engineer act on its behalf to have plans drawn for the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that, when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to replace a culvert and improve the roadway on a portion of Clotts Road, between the township line near Riva Ridge Boulevard and the entrance to Gahanna Middle School East, in Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2) That the Franklin County Engineer, by his request, is hereby authorized and directed to investigate and recommend to this Board a consulting engineer to be employed to assist him in the preparation of plans and all other related documents for the above mentioned improvement.
