

Resolution authorizing the submission of a Phase 2 grant application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety Emergency Management Agency related to the mitigation of flooding associated with Whims Ditch (Commissioners)

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners approved by resolution the State-Local Grant Agreement for the Whims Ditch Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, which sought to acquire and demolish 21 residential structures to mitigate the impact of repetitive flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Drainage Engineer, the sub-grantee of the State-Local Grant Agreement and Project Manager for the Whims Ditch project, has received numerous inquiries from the owners of residences affected by the flooding but not included in the first grant program; and

WHEREAS, with the initial grant program nearing completion, the Franklin County Drainage Engineer has recommended that Franklin County submit an application for a second Hazard Mitigation Grant Program to include eligible participants in a Whims Ditch—Phase 2 project;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Franklin County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the submission of a “Phase 2” grant application for the State of Ohio Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (FEMA-4002-DR-OH) related to the mitigation of flooding associated with Whims Ditch.
