

Resolution to consider access management regulations and establish an advisory committee (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Chapter 5552 of the Ohio Revised Code enables counties and townships to pass access management regulations; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, the County Engineer requested that the Board of County Commissioners consider the adoption of access management regulations and establish an Advisory Committee to review proposed regulations; and

WHEREAS, this Advisory Committee shall consist of the County Engineer, or his designee, a registered surveyor, a representative of the homebuilding industry, a licensed realtor, a representative from the regional planning commission, a professional engineer, a representative of the metropolitan planning organization, at least three (3) township trustees, and a member of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer shall draft the regulations, which will be made available to the public, and the Advisory Committee will give recommendations to the County Commissioners on these regulations; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners will hold two (2) public hearings regarding these regulations and may adopt the proposed access management regulations in light of the Advisory Committee's findings;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Board of County Commissioners hereby requests the County Engineer to draft proposed access management regulations

Section 2) That the Board of County Commissioners hereby establishes an Advisory Committee to review the proposed access management regulations

Section 3) That copies of the proposed regulations shall be made available to the public at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Engineer's Office
