

Resolution authorizing a contract with Ohio University for the transition of the Emergency Responder’s 3D Immersive Video Imaging Network to Franklin County through the Urban Area Security Initiative grant (OHS&JP) (\$6,915.00)

WHEREAS, the Urban Area Security Initiative grant authorizes contracts/consultants to be paid for services that strengthen the target capability of critical infrastructure protection; and

WHEREAS, Ohio University has completed Phase 1 and 2 of filming and development of an Emergency Responder’s 3D Immersive Video Imaging Network (IVIN) for area safety responders and is prepared to transition the final product to the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office for housing and administration; and

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Advisory Committee has allocated six thousand nine hundred fifteen dollars to support the transfer of the IVIN system to Franklin County from FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract is for the period April 1, 2012 through July 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Purchasing Department and the Franklin County Prosecutor’s Office have reviewed the contract and found it to be acceptable as to form.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached contract for services and purchase order detailed on the accompanying Purchase Order Proof List are hereby approved with compensation not to exceed the listed amount.
