

Establishing, altering and widening of Winchester Pike at Shannon Road and Ebright Road, the City of Columbus, Madison Township, Franklin County, Ohio declared necessary (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, provided that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to establish, alter and widen Winchester Pike, County Road No. 376, at Shannon Road and Ebright Road, County Road No. 118, the City of Columbus, Madison Township, Franklin County, Ohio to variable widths upon the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of Winchester Pike at Shannon Road and Ebright Road for approximately 1000 feet in each direction

Section 2) That Tuesday, May 1, 2012 at 11:00 a.m., on the line of the proposed improvement, is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing said intersection of Winchester Pike and Shannon Road and Ebright Road.

Section 3) That the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio is hereby directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in accordance with the law.
