

**Resolution authorizing a transfer of appropriations to support the purchase of a new health care information management system. (Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Board)**

**WHEREAS**, the 2012 budget of the Franklin County Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health (ADAMH) Board includes \$2,000,000 in Capital Outlays for the purchase of a new healthcare information management system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County ADAMH Board formed the Three C Recovery and Health Care Network Council of Government (COG) with Hamilton and Cuyahoga Counties pursuant to Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

**WHEREAS**, each of the three participating Counties will contribute equal shares to the COG to purchase the new healthcare information management system; and

**WHEREAS**, the formation of the COG has necessitated a transfer in appropriations from Capital Outlays to Grants in order for the COG to purchase the new healthcare information management system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County ADAMH Board has requested the transfer of appropriation in the amount of \$2,000,000 in the ADAMH Levy Fund (Fund 2111) for the purpose described above; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$2,000,000 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #72):
