

Resolution authorizing May 8, 2012 as the Franklin County Commissioners Employee Recognition Day. (Human Resources) (not to exceed \$3,000)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners plans to recognize the hard work and dedication of its approximately 1,400 employees at an employee recognition event; and

WHEREAS, the event will take place on May 8, 2012 at Franklin County Veterans Memorial; and

WHEREAS, the event will recognize and honor employees celebrating years of service milestones and will also honor the 2011 Employees of the Year chosen by their departments and peers.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to use public funds for the provision of snacks (vegetables, fruit, cake, etc...), non-alcoholic beverages (pop, coffee, water, etc...), corsages, and ancillary items for the furthering of morale of the agency employees; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is necessary to meet the proper public purpose expenditure requirements as set forth in Ohio Attorney General Opinion 82-006 and Auditor of State Bulletins 2003-005 and 2004-002; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the board declares May 8, 2012 as Franklin County Commissioners Employee Recognition Day and finds and hereby declares it to be a proper and necessary public purpose to provide snacks, non-alcoholic beverages, and other ancillary items for those individuals who attend the event.
2. That the attached purchase orders totaling \$3,000 for the purchase of snacks, non-alcoholic beverages, corsages, and other ancillary items that are individually described on the accompanying Purchase Order Proof List are hereby approved.
