

Resolution authorizing a transfer of appropriations in the General Fund for Law Enforcement Emergency Radio Network (LEERN) radios (Sheriff)

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has mandated that all VHF radios be "narrowbanded" by January 1, 2013, therefore, requiring the Sheriff's Office to replace their current VHF radios; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's office currently uses VHF LEERN radios to communicate with out-of-county law enforcement agencies for assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff has requested to replace 50 LEERN radios in their patrol, convey, and specialty vehicles (e.g. SWAT and bomb squad), as well as two base transmitters; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff has requested a transfer of appropriations from the Reserve held for the Sheriff's Office within the Commissioners budget to the Sheriff's Materials and Services (\$34,980) and Capital Outlays (\$12,514) budgets to cover the costs associated with the replacement LEERN radios; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$47,494 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2626):
