

Resolution entering into a Funding Agreement with the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment to provide hearing enhancement equipment and handicapped accessibility services for disabled low-income Franklin County residents
(Economic Development & Planning) (\$25,000.00)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, Franklin County has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant for certain community development activities; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 94-12 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's 2012 Annual Action Plan and which was approved by the Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledging this community development need, fulfilling all requisite citizen participation requirements related to that plan and approving this allocation within; and

WHEREAS, this contract with the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment provides hearing enhancement equipment and handicapped accessibility services for disabled low-income Franklin County residents; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grant recipient--Franklin County Commissioners--and the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment prior to the disbursement of CDBG funds; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO

That the attached Funding Agreement in the amount of \$25,000 and the Purchase Order in the amount of \$15,000 between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment for Hearing Enhancement Services is hereby approved.
