

Resolution authorizing a General Fund transfer of appropriations and a Service Agreement with Franklin County Public Health for a Home Sewage Treatment system Program (Economic Development and Planning)

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Clean Water Act, as amended (the "CWA"), authorizes the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency to make capitalization grants to states to establish a state water pollution control revolving loan fund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the CWA, states may provide loans and other types of financial assistance from a water pollution control revolving loan fund to local communities for the construction of source pollution control management programs and development and implementation of plans under the estuary protection programs; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners has secured State of Ohio Water Pollution Control Fund (WPCF) financial assistance (funded through the CWA) to implement Home Sewage Treatment System Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners wishes to engage Franklin County Public Health in utilizing WPCF dollars for such a Home Sewage Treatment System program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$160,000 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #10):
