

Disposal of personal property obsolete and not needed for public use by Franklin County agencies and authorizing the sale of said items via internet auction (Children Services)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Children Services (FCCS) has identified personal property as obsolete and not needed for public use and listed said items on the attached listing;

WHEREAS, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners (BOC), pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 307.12, is authorized to declare personal property as unneeded, obsolete or unfit and not needed for public use and to sale said items via Internet auction;

WHEREAS, the BOC adopted Resolution No. 683-06, on August 29, 2006, emphasizing its commitment to promote sustainable principles in policy decisions and programs;

WHEREAS, in keeping with the intent of Resolution No. 683-06, FCCS encourages the adoption of waste management policies that reduce the environmental impact of solid waste and lessen the burden on the Franklin County landfill;

WHEREAS, at FCCS' regularly scheduled meeting on **October 31, 2012**, allowed approval to request formal recommendation to the BOC for disposal of said personal property; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That BOC's declares the personal property identified by FCCS and detailed in the attached listing as obsolete and not needed for public use.

That the BOC's authorizes the sale via Internet auction that personal property identified by FCCS and detailed in the attached listing, per the terms and conditions of the Franklin County's Sellers Agreement with GovDeals, Inc.

That in the event no qualified bid is received for an item, FCCS authorizes that item to be made available for recycling and disposed of in a manner consistent with the intent of Resolution No. 683-06.
