

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Robert Klemann for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy (Sheriff) (\$500)

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2012, Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy Brian Felkner was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, a stopped vehicle, owned by Robert Klemann was struck from behind by a Patrol vehicle on Fodor Road; and

WHEREAS, both vehicles sustained damage in the accident, and no injuries were reported at the time of the accident; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will pay for the damage in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the damages done to Robert Klemann's vehicle in the accident that occurred on October 14, 2012; and Robert Klemann has accepted contingent on approval by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates Robert Klemann for the damages to his vehicle; and

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither Deputy Brian Felkner, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Sheriff's Office admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to settle the vehicle claim for Five Hundred Dollars (\$500); and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Sheriff's Office, and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.

That upon execution of a full release in favor of the Franklin County Commissioners, Department of Fleet Management, and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office that is satisfactory to the Prosecutor's Office; a warrant be issued payable to Robert Klemann, and forwarded to 113 Hidden Hills Drive, Pataskala, Ohio 43062 as full and final settlement of this matter.
