

Resolution approving a statement of work agreement with CH Mack, Inc. for software upgrades for the Q Case Management System

(Office On Aging) Estimated Amount \$71,396

**WHEREAS,** This Statement of Work, is made by and between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners on behalf of the Franklin County Office on Aging (hereinafter "FCOA") and CH Mack, Inc.

**WHEREAS,** CH Mack, Inc. is an independent software and services provider for the health and human/social services industry and has developed certain software product(s) for commercial use; and;

**WHEREAS,** FCOA is engaging CH Mack, Inc. to modify the Q Continuum System with a series of Enhancements that will allow FCOA to better serve their customers; under the terms and conditions contained in this Statement; and

**WHEREAS,** the term of the contract is from the date of signing until completion; and

**WHEREAS,** A detailed project plan and schedule will be agreed to in writing within 30 days of contract execution.

**WHEREAS,** this project with CH Mack, Inc. has been reviewed by the Automatic Data Processing Board, and approved through Resolution #12-089-9750. The cost of this project is not expected to exceed \$71,396.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached contract with CH Mack, Inc. and the attached purchase order in the amount of \$35,698.00 for the remainder of 2012 are hereby approved. The remaining portion in the amount of \$35,698.00 will be opened in a purchase order in 2013.
