

Resolution authorizing a contract with Fred Bowditch for the purchase of consultant services to support target capability enhancement through the Urban Area Security Initiative Grant (OHS&JP \$46,875.00)

WHEREAS, the Urban Area Security Initiative grant authorizes contracts/consultants to be paid for system-wide planning as it relates to building target capabilities, critical infrastructure protection and information gathering and intelligence analysis; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has designated Critical Infrastructure Protection and Information Sharing and Intelligence Analysis as National Priorities for preparedness and homeland security; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs on behalf of the Homeland Security Advisory Committee and Franklin County agrees to enter into a contract with Fred Bowditch for the purpose of coordination with the Terrorism Early Warning Group and system wide target capability planning; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract is for the period December 15, 2012 through July 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office and the Franklin County Purchasing Department have reviewed the attached contract and found it to be acceptable as to form.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached consultant agreement with Fred Bowditch is hereby approved and that expenses for CY's 2012 and 2013 will not be liquidated until CY 2013; therefore, a purchase order not to exceed the contract amount of \$46,875.00 will be opened in January 2013.
