

**Resolution expressing support of the Home Energy Affordability Loan (HEAL) program to be piloted by the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission.
(Commissioners)**

WHEREAS, the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) has been granted an opportunity to provide the Home Energy Affordability Loan (HEAL) program to Franklin County employees;

WHEREAS, the William J. Clinton Foundation extended the contract(s) with MORPC to pilot the program to MORPC employees initially with plans to provide the program to other Franklin County Payroll System employees at a later date; and

WHEREAS, the Home Energy Affordability Loan (HEAL) program will provide home energy efficiency retrofits that will have numerous and lasting impacts on employees and their communities through lower energy bills, safer, more comfortable homes, and a stronger local economy.

WHEREAS, the funding for the program will be through utility company assessment/audit fees, rebates available for customers from the utilities, and other fees; and

WHEREAS, though the program is sponsored by the Clinton Foundation there is no financial backing from the Foundation, nor any additional financial payments to be paid to the Foundation: and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners supports the efforts of MORPC in bringing the Home Energy Affordability loan (HEAL) program to Franklin County employees; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Franklin County Board of Commissioners expresses its full support for the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) bringing a pilot program of the Home Energy Affordability Loan (HEAL) program to MORPC employees.
