

Resolution requesting the Ohio Department of Transportation to reduce the speed limit on Georgesville Road, County Road No. 26, Franklin County, Ohio (Engineer)

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2012 the Board approved Resolution No. 0206-12 temporarily lowering the speed to 35 mph from 45 mph during roadway construction; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Engineer's Office has requested a speed limit reduction on Georgesville Road, County Road No. 26, from the corporation limit just south of the Camp Chase Railroad crossing to West Broad Street, requiring the Franklin County Commissioners to request that the Ohio Department of Transportation evaluate the present speed limit; and

WHEREAS, the permanent speed limit currently on this section of Georgesville Road is 45 mph;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Ohio Department of Transportation is hereby requested to investigate and determine a safe speed limit on Georgesville Road, County Road No. 26 from the corporation limit just south of the Camp Chase Railroad crossing to West Broad Street, as detailed herein.

Section 2) That when the office of the Franklin County Engineer is notified of the change in speed limit, the appropriate signs will be erected.
