

Resolution authorizing a preliminary agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation for the Relocating of Waterlines on West Broad Street

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners has jurisdiction, ownership, and maintenance responsibilities over certain waterline infrastructure, facilities, and associated apparatuses on West Broad Street in Franklin Township, specifically between Interstate 270 and Georgesville Road; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has plans to construct certain improvements along West Broad Street in Franklin Township, generally between Interstate 270 and Georgesville Road (ODOT PID 83018); and

WHEREAS, the waterline infrastructure, facilities, associated apparatuses under the jurisdiction of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners on West Broad Street need to be relocated as part of the Ohio Department of Transportation Project; and

WHEREAS, the funds for this project will be financed via the State Infrastructure Bank, as administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation as per Resolution 759-12; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. The Franklin County Board of Commissioners via the Department of Sanitary Engineering hereby agrees to cooperate with the Director of Transportation of the State of Ohio in the planning, design and construction of the waterline improvements and grants consent to the Ohio Department of Transportation for its development and construction of the project in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates as approved by the Director.
2. The State agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of Preliminary Engineering.
3. Franklin County Board of Commissioners via the Department of Sanitary Engineering agrees to assume and bear one hundred

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percent (100%) of the construction cost and inspection of the water line.

4. Franklin County Board of Commissioners via the Department of Sanitary Engineering agrees to acquire and/or make available to ODOT, in accordance with current State and Federal regulations, all necessary right-of-way required for the described Project. The Department of Sanitary Engineering also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs. The Franklin County Board of Commissioners agrees to be responsible for all utility accommodation, relocation, and reimbursement and agrees that all such accommodations, relocations, and reimbursements shall comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.
5. Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners via the Department of Sanitary Engineering shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described waterline improvements in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described waterline improvements; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

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
