

**Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Office of Management and Budget to perform a cost analysis study on the services provided by the Department of Animal Care and Control. (Animal Care and Control)**

**WHEREAS**, section 955.17 of the Revised Code provides that a Board of County Commissioners may authorize the County to perform or contract for the performance of a cost analysis study to determine the costs to the County of performing the services required under sections 955.12, 955.15, and 955.16; and

**WHEREAS**, section 955.17 also provides that the scope of the study be defined and the costs to be analyzed are to be itemized and shall include the direct and any reasonable indirect costs to the County for the services related to the impounding of dogs; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Franklin County Office of Management and Budget is hereby authorized to perform a cost analysis study to determine the costs for the impounding and boarding of dogs pursuant to sections 955.12, 955.15, and 955.16 of the Revised Code.
2. That the scope of the study shall include analysis on the direct and indirect costs associated with the impounding and boarding of animals by the Animal Care and Control Department.
