

**Resolution authorizing recycling of information technology equipment as identified by the Franklin County Automatic Data Processing Board.  
(Public Facilities Management)**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Automatic Data Processing Board has identified information technology equipment as available for recycling; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to the provisions of ORC Section 307.12, is authorized to dispose of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 683-06 on August 29, 2006, emphasizing its commitment to promote sustainable principles in policy decisions and programs; and

**WHEREAS**, in keeping with the intent of Resolution No. 683-06, the Board of County Commissioners encourages the adoption of waste management policies and practices which reduce the environmental impact of discarded solid waste and delivery of that product to the Franklin County landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the declaration of the Franklin County Automatic Data Processing Board.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That Public Facilities Management is authorized to dispose of the information technology equipment identified by the Franklin County Automatic Data Processing Board as available for recycling and detailed in the attached listing.
