

Resolution authorizing a reimbursement agreement with the City of Columbus for purchasing and installing six (6) outdoor warning sirens (Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security) (\$120,000.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security (FCEM&HS) is responsible for purchasing, installing, and maintaining new outdoor warning sirens; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus will expand siren system coverage to additional areas by purchasing six (6) additional sirens in 2013; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of purchasing and installing six (6) additional sirens will not exceed \$120,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the agreement documents submitted by the City of Columbus shall be the governing documents which are fully incorporated herein, and are binding upon both parties; and,

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the reimbursement agreement documents and found them to be acceptable as to form; and,

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be from January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2014 ; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the attached warning siren system reimbursement agreement with the City of Columbus is hereby approved.
