

Establishing, altering and widening of Alkire Road at Darby Creek Drive, Pleasant Township, Franklin County, Ohio, declared necessary (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, provided that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to establish, alter and widen Alkire Road, County Road No. 11, at Darby Creek Drive, Pleasant Township, Franklin County, Ohio, to variable widths upon the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of Alkire Road and Darby Creek Drive for approximately 750 feet in each direction.

Section 2) That Tuesday, April 2, 2013 at 11:00 a.m., on the line of the proposed improvement, is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing said intersection of Alkire Road at Darby Creek Drive.

Section 3) That the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio is hereby directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in accordance with the law.
