

Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations related to the award of various grants. (Emergency Management & Homeland Security)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security has been awarded an Urban Area Security Initiative grant in the amount of \$160,000 for the purchase and installation of 8 new outdoor warning sirens for the City of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security has been awarded three State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grants totaling \$197,368 for Central Ohio Typed Hazmat Team Sustainment (\$107,568), Radiation Detection Sustainment (\$24,800) and FCEM&HS Functional Exercise (\$65,000); and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security has been awarded an Emergency Management Program Grant (EMPG) in the amount of \$10,800 for the purchase and installation of a new controller for the Franklin County Outdoor Warning Siren System; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations for these grants were not included in the 2013 Approved Budget; and

WHEREAS, all of the projects are expected to be completed in 2013 and current appropriation levels cannot support the expenditures needed to utilize these grants; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security is requesting supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$378,968 in order to utilize these grants; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$378,968 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2516):
