

Establishing, altering and widening of Clark-State Road at Highland Woods Drive, Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio, declared necessary (Engineer)

WHEREAS, Section 5553.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, provided that when the Board of County Commissioners is of the opinion that it will be necessary for public convenience and welfare to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten, vacate or change the direction of a public road, it shall so declare by resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That it is necessary for public convenience and welfare that proceedings be initiated to establish, alter and widen Clark-State Road at Highland Woods Drive, Jefferson Township, Franklin County, Ohio, to variable widths upon the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of Clark-State Road and Highland Woods Drive for approximately 750 feet in each direction.

Section 2) That Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at 11:00 a.m., on the line of the proposed improvement, is hereby fixed as the time and place for viewing said improvement of Clark-State Road.

Section 3) That the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio is hereby directed to cause legal publication thereof to be made in accordance with the law.
