

Resolution authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding and a transfer of appropriations for the continuation of support for the Addiction and Solicitation Specialized Dockets. (Commissioners)(\$340,000)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution #559-09 to support a collaborative pilot project establishing specialty court dockets for individuals whose violations may not have occurred except for their addiction to alcohol or other drugs, and to assist chronic violations of solicitation laws; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution #90-12 to continue support of the Addiction and Solicitation Specialized Dockets for calendar year 2012; and

WHEREAS, this collaborative project was established since jails should not be holding facilities for persons suffering from mental illness, nor are they effective means in assisting individuals dealing with chronic addictions to alcohol or other drugs; and

WHEREAS, these specialized dockets have successfully helped people rebuild their lives, end addiction, and reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to continue its support of the Addiction and Solicitation Specialized dockets for calendar year 2013; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the attached Memorandum of Understanding for the support of the Addiction and Solicitation Program Specialized Dockets for 2013 is hereby approved.
2. That a transfer of appropriation in the amount of \$340,000 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #67):
