

**Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Office Special Projects  
Community Outreach fund (Sheriff)**

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office in part is to protect the lives and property of the citizens of Franklin County, to preserve the peace, and to prevent crime and disorder while constantly guarding personal liberties as prescribed by law; and

**WHEREAS**, to accomplish this mission, it is a goal of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to develop a strong, close working relationship with the Franklin County community by establishing Community Outreach programs; and

**WHEREAS**, a fund has been established for the acceptance of donations to benefit Community Outreach projects conducted by the Franklin County Sheriff's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the donations will be utilized for expenses as outlined in the attached policy to benefit Community Outreach projects; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

- 1) The Special Projects Community Outreach fund (2142) is hereby approved and recognized.
- 2) With the authority to accept donations and gifts granted to the County per ORC 9.20, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to accept donations and gifts in its stead.
- 3) The attached Franklin County Sheriff's Office Administrative Regulation AR407 approved and accepted by the Sheriff and County Auditor is hereby recognized as the expenditure authority for the Special Projects Community Outreach fund (2142).
