

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Shamis Farah for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy (Sheriff) (\$500)

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2013, a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy Roland Stewart was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, a vehicle owned by Shamis Farah was struck in the front driver side bumper by a Patrol vehicle while traveling northbound on Westerville Avenue; and

WHEREAS, both vehicles sustained damage in the accident, and no injuries were reported at the time of the accident; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will pay for the damage in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the damages done to Shamis Farah's vehicle in the accident that occurred on March 24, 2013; and Shamis Farah has accepted contingent on approval by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates Shamis Farah for the damages to her vehicle; and

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither Deputy Roland Stewart, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Sheriff's Office admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners and the Franklin County Sheriff's Office to settle the vehicle claim for Five Hundred Dollars (\$500); and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Sheriff's Office, and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
