

Authorize a Loan Repayment Agreement between The Franklin County Board of Commissioners and Mifflin Township for Engineering and Design of the Leonard Park Water Distribution System

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and Mifflin Township believe that providing the Leonard Park Subdivision with a reliable and quality water supply is a project of great importance and one which will enhance the future health and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Mifflin Township and Franklin County Board of Commissioners (County) wish to see constructed a water distribution system to service the Leonard Park Subdivision of Mifflin Township; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that it can design and construct a water distribution system, and connect said system to its existing water distribution system and thereby provide water service to Leonard Park Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the parties have determined that in order to make water services available to Leonard Park Subdivision it is necessary and advisable for the County to apply for and obtain a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan from the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA); and

WHEREAS, Mifflin has agreed to reimburse the County for the principal, interest and associated costs to the County of repaying the loan; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the attached Loan Repayment Agreement between Franklin County Board of Commissioners and Mifflin Township is hereby approved.
