

Resolution authorizing a contract with Alvis, Inc. dba Alvis House for providing pre and post release Comprehensive Social and and Supportive case management services for female offenders at the Ohio Reformatory for Women

Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs' Re-Entry Task Force Est. Contract Amount: \$84,869.00

WHEREAS, competitive sealed proposals were received and opened by the Purchasing Department for Re-Entry Services on April 24, 2013 (RFP# 2013-13-16); and

WHEREAS, after review and evaluation Alvis, Inc. dba Alvis House was the determined to be the lowest and best proposer for providing Comprehensive Social and Supportive case management services; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice and Bureau of Justice Assistance has awarded to Franklin County a Second Chance Act Technology Careers Training Demonstration Project for Incarcerated Adults and Juveniles Grant in the amount of \$747,859.00 for the provision of re-entry services intended to reduce re-cividism, increase opportunities for sustained employment while improving re-integration and re-entry outcomes of female ex-offenders; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract shall be in effect beginning from date of Franklin County Board of Commissioner approval through September 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney's Office and Purchasing Department have reviewed the contract and found them to be acceptable as to form; now therefore
