

Resolution adopting the proposed fees for impounding, boarding and licensing of dogs. (Animal Care and Control)

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 955.17 of the Revised Code, the Board of County Commissioners may conduct a study to establish fees equal to or less than actual and indirect costs incurred by the County when impounding and boarding dogs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution No. 0119-13 to authorized the Franklin County Office of Management and Budget to perform a cost analysis study to determine the costs for the impounding and boarding of dogs and the associated fees to charge beginning in fiscal year 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Management and Budget has completed the cost analysis study and a public hearing has been held on June 18, 2013 to consider the proposed fees that are included in the study; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to implement the fees that are outlined in the cost analysis study and to increase the annual licensing fee pursuant to section 955.14 if the Revised Code; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached cost analysis study and the fee proposal attached and referenced as Exhibit A are hereby approved.
