

Resolution authorizing a contract with Fred Bowditch for the purchase of consultant services with respect to matters related to Whole Communities and Risk Management through the FY2011 Homeland Security Grant (Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security) (\$56,250.00)

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency has approved the requested project submitted by Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security on behalf of the Homeland Security Advisory Committee and Franklin County agrees to enter into a contract with Fred Bowditch for the purpose of Community Resilience, CyberSecurity, Infrastructure Systems and Physical Protective Measures, Information Gathering and Intelligence Sharing and Analysis and Public/Private Partnerships as it relates to coordination with the Terrorism Early Warning Group and system wide target capability planning; and,
