

Resolution authorizing a non-general fund supplemental appropriation in the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund. (Commissioners)

WHEREAS, Franklin County is responsible for the administration of Wireless 9-1-1 Government Assistance funds received from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio are deposited into the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund (Fund 2130); and

WHEREAS, expenditures are anticipated to be higher than the 2013 approved budget due to the carryover of 2012 expenditures into the current year; and

WHEREAS, a supplemental appropriation within the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund in the amount of \$800,000 is necessary to support the distribution of Wireless 9-1-1 Government Assistance funds to the County’s five primary Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$800,000 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #506):
