

**Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations for installing upgrades to the video surveillance system. (Emergency Management & Homeland Security)**

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Emergency Management & Homeland Security (FCEM&HS) is responsible for maintaining 24-hour emergency operations for Franklin County; and

**WHEREAS**, to achieve the goal of providing a safe location for its staff and property, FCEM&HS is installing upgrades to a video surveillance system on both the interior and exterior of its building; and

**WHEREAS**, FCEM&HS did not include the project in the 2013 budget but funding for the project has been received from the 2012 Supplemental Emergency Management Program; and

**WHEREAS**, FCEM&HS is requesting supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$44,802 in order to install the upgrades to its video surveillance system; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$44,802 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2231):
