

Resolution authorizing a software license agreement with BAIR Analytics for the purchase of Crime Analysis Software (Sheriff) (\$17,300)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office has a need to further analyze crime data and trends in the community to proactively police and better serve the citizens of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, with this goal in mind, the Sheriff's Office, through re-organization, has created a crime analyst position for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, BAIR Analytics has software capable of crime pattern analysis, predictive analytics and crime mapping and reporting to allow resources to be deployed in the most efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Sheriff's Office asset forfeiture account known as the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – Federal Treasury will be utilized to purchase the software at a cost of \$17,300; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office recognizes that the Franklin County Commissioners continue to support its current efforts, and requests further support and approval of this software license agreement; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1) The Franklin County Commissioners hereby approve the software license agreement with BAIR Analytics
