

Resolution entering into a Funding Agreement with the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) for an Urgent Repair Housing Rehabilitation Program
(Economic Development & Planning Department) (\$700,000)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, the Grantee has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME funds for certain community development activities; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 102-13 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's 2013 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledging this community development need, fulfilling all requisite citizen participation requirements related to that plan and approving this allocation within; and

WHEREAS, this contract with the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission will allow for urgent repair and rehabilitation of low-income Franklin County homes; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grant recipient the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the grantee MORPC prior to the disbursement of CDBG or HOME funds; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached Funding Agreement in the amount of \$700,000 and purchase order both in the amount of \$130,000 between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) to allow for urgent repair and rehabilitation of low-income single-family homes in Franklin County.

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
