

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to enter into intergovernmental agreements with the City of Columbus and Village of Russells Point to administer the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security grant funds (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States of America has created funding resources through the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Grant Program to assist local agencies' ability to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from all hazards incidents; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County serves as the fiscal agent for the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the City of Columbus and Village of Russells Point wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Franklin County to provide for the proper legal and audit controls required to expend homeland security grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the intergovernmental agreements and found them to be acceptable as to form; now, therefore,
