WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services has awarded the Franklin County Coroner's Office a \$6,085.61 Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant for the Training and Education of Franklin County Coroner's Staff; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires no local contribution or other matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the grant program is for a period of twelve months ending on September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Coroner's Office recommends that the Franklin County Commissioners approve the acceptance of this grant; and therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1) Approval of the attached Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant to fund the Training and Education of Franklin County Coroner's Staff in the amount of \$6085.61 is hereby authorized.
- 2) No local contribution or other matching funds is required.
- 3) The Franklin County Commissioners hereby release signature authority for the duration of the grant period to Dr. Jan M. Gorniak, Coroner for all sub-grant adjustments, quarterly financial reports and all other grant related documentation as allowed by the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant titled "Training and Education of Franklin County Coroner's Staff".
