

Resolution authorizing a contract with Battelle to provide a Needs Assessment and System Specifications Study for a Franklin County Mass Notification System (Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security) (\$153,153.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security (FCEM&HS) has a requirement to assess the need for a comprehensive Countywide mass notification system; and

WHEREAS, Battelle has a demonstrated expertise in studying mass notification systems and providing specifications for those systems; and,

WHEREAS, the contract will be paid for utilizing FY11 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant and FY13 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) funds; and,

WHEREAS, the term of the contract shall be in effect on and between February 18, 2014 through July 15, 2014, and remain in effect until the end date as noted above or until the contract is fully performed by both parties; now, therefore,
