

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency to enter into a IV-D contract with the Franklin County Data Center

(CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY) (\$84,170.93)

WHEREAS, THE Franklin County Data Center provides data processing services to all county agencies pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 307.84 and 307.84.6; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Data Center staff performs data processing functions under the auspices of Franklin County Data Processing Board personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency requests approval to use data processing equipment and services of the Franklin County Data Center according to the terms and conditions of the attached IV-D Service Contract/Interagency Service Agreement for the period of March 1, 2014, through February 28, 2015; and

WHEREAS, all cost for this service are not claimed through direct and indirect service charges as established by MAXIMUS, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the maximum direct expenditures of funds under this Agreement shall not exceed \$84,170.93; and

WHEREAS, the attached purchase order encumbrance has been pre-certified as to the availability of funds by the County Auditor for payment, now therefore:
