

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Engineer to enter into agreements with various agencies for the 2014 Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) Resurfacing Program project (Engineer)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Engineer was awarded a 1.1 million dollar grant from the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC); and

WHEREAS, these funds are a portion of MORPC's 2014 Regional Resurfacing Program project and intended to be used by the Franklin County Engineer to resurface roads throughout Franklin County, Fairfield County and Licking County including various municipalities, villages, and unincorporated areas; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for the Franklin County Engineer to enter into agreements with various local governmental agencies to insure that the contractor has the proper authorization to work within the various jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, there will be some cases where financial reimbursement agreements will need to be established where the scope of the desired work by the various agencies exceeds the allocated MORPC funding; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Franklin County Engineer is hereby empowered on behalf of the County to enter into contracts with various governmental agencies as necessary to complete the 2014 MORPC Regional Resurfacing Program project.

Section 2) That the board does hereby declare it necessary that the proceedings be initiated for the improvement of various sections of the following roads with asphalt and aggregate berm material: Groveport Road, Havens Corners Road, Mink Street (Licking County), New Albany Road East, Pickerington Road NW (Fairfield County), Valley View Drive, and U.S. Route 62.
