

Resolution authorizing a transfer of non-general fund appropriations to support the Computer Assisted Mass Appraisal Project. (Auditor)

WHEREAS, Resolution #114-13 authorized an agreement with Tyler Technologies, Inc. to develop a Computer Assisted Mass Appraisal (CAMA) system for use in the appraisal of real estate within Franklin County for tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Computer Assisted Mass Appraisal (CAMA) Project is scheduled for completion in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Auditor’s Office has indicated that a transfer of appropriations will be required in the Real Estate Assessment Fund (Fund 2013) relating to a change order on the project for data transfer, part/parcel conversion, public access, advisory and maintenance services; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Auditor’s Office has requested a transfer of non-general fund appropriations in the amount of \$343,840.00 from Materials & Services to Capital Outlays to support continued capital expenditures in 2014 for the Computer Assisted Mass Appraisal (CAMA) project; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$343,843.00 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #873):
