

**Resolution authorizing supplemental appropriations for the purchase of computers and other equipment. (Public Defender)**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners adopted Resolutions No. 877-13 and 891-13, authorizing contracts for the purchase of replacement desktop, laptop and tablet computers in support of the Windows XP end of life to Windows 7 operating system upgrade initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, centralized ordering and payment for these computers was handled by the Franklin County Data Center, including the purchase of 46 desktop computers and 54 tablet computers for the Franklin County Public Defender’s Office at a cost of \$95,472.52; and

**WHEREAS**, the transition to Windows 7 has also necessitated the replacement of 2 scanners which are incompatible with the new operating system at a cost of \$47,800; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Public Defender is reimbursed by the Office of the Ohio Public Defender at a rate of 40% for all expenses and reimbursed by the City of Columbus at a rate of 40% for the remaining expenses related to the equipment allocated to the Municipal Court program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$143,272.52 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #1399):
