

Resolution Approving Plans and Authorizing the Advertisement for the Construction of the Leonard Park Water System Improvements Project

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners recognizes the dire need to provide reliable and quality water to Franklin County residents with failing well systems via a mutual cooperation between the City of Columbus and the County of Franklin, Ohio as per Resolution 989-10; and

WHEREAS, the Leonard Park area had been identified as one of the first of these areas to receive water via the Water Quality Partnership program as per Resolution 193-11; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering desires to construct water mains in the Leonard Park area; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the water main design and construction will be paid from loans secured from the Ohio Public Works Commission and the Ohio Water Development Authority with Mifflin Township reimbursement of design fees via an executed Intergovernmental Agreement (Resolution 0402-13); and

WHEREAS, the plans and bid documents for this project have been approved by the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Director of the Franklin County Department of Sanitary Engineering is authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of water mains as part of the Leonard Park Water System Improvements project.

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
