

Resolution entering into a funding agreement with Rebuilding Together Central Ohio to provide a Tool Loan Program and launch "Rebuilding a Healthy Neighborhood" event
(Economic Development & Planning) (\$50,000.00)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, Franklin County has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for certain community development activities; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 108-14 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's 2014 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledging this community development need, fulfilling all requisite citizen participation requirements related to that plan and approving this allocation within; and

WHEREAS, this contract with Rebuilding Together Central Ohio supports its tool loan program to low-income Franklin County residents and nonprofit partners as well as "Rebuilding a Healthy Neighborhood," a two-day event of rehabilitation and/or modification of homes in the designated low-income neighborhood of Broadlawn; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grant recipient, i.e., Franklin County Board of Commissioners, and Rebuilding Together Central Ohio prior to the disbursement of CDBG funds; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the attached funding agreement and purchase order in the amount of \$50,000 between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and Rebuilding Together Central Ohio, for a tool loan program and "Rebuilding a Healthy Neighborhood" program, are hereby approved.
