

Resolution authorizing a non-general fund supplemental appropriation for the purchase of a replacement vehicle. (Sanitary Engineer)

WHEREAS, the Department of Sanitary Engineering has indicated that the current sludge truck is over 10 years old and is no longer operational; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Sanitary Engineering is projected to expend approximately \$60,000 a year to contract this service out; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Sanitary Engineering has requested a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$166,759 for the purchase of a replacement sludge truck; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Sanitary Engineering has indicated that the current sludge truck has a trade in value of \$5,500, which has been deducted from the cost of the replacement sludge truck; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$166,759 is hereby authorized as follows from the unappropriated cash balances and allocated per the attached document (Journal #3440):
