

Resolution authorizing a non-general fund supplemental appropriation in the Justice Assistance Grant Fund. (Sheriff)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office operate various the Community Policing initiatives is to increase public safety awareness and provide training and materials for the operation of programs, including Neighborhood Block Watch, TRIAD and Citizen Academy; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office has been awarded a 2013 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) grant from the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs (OHS&JP) in the amount of \$3,478.42 for the purchase of additional safety equipment for the citizens academy participants; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office has requested a supplemental appropriation within the JAG Fund (Fund 2086) in the amount of \$3,478.42 for the above mentioned expenditures which were not originally included in the 2014 budget; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$3,478.42 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per attached document (Journal #2907):
