

**Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations from the Motor Vehicle & Gas Tax Fund for the township resurfacing project and the purchase of additional rock salt.**

**(Engineer)**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Engineer’s Office has indicated that the 2014 township resurfacing project is estimated to cost \$1,000,000 more than the 2014 budgeted amount; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Engineer’s Office has also indicated that the townships will reimburse the county for resurfacing work completed on their behalf within the Motor Vehicle & Gas Tax Fund (\$1,000,000); and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Engineer’s Office has indicated that due to the unusually severe weather experienced during the 2013-2014 winter season, the County’s rock salt levels are below the desired inventory amount, and an additional 7,000 tons are required to be purchased at an estimated cost of \$300,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Engineer’s Office has requested supplemental appropriations for the purposes described above in the amount of \$1,300,000; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$1,300,000 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #4):
